SleepTime™ – More than a Biomarker Abstinence versus levels in regard to EtG

EASTON, CT. – In lieu of recent articles on the role of biomarkers in treatment and detection of alcohol abuse, Chris Crucilla, Drug Recognition Expert and Vice President of Drug Impairment Detection Services, DBA, StreeTime Technologies has issued a statement on this issue. *The Advisory*, a publication distributed by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, an agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, published an article on September 25, 2006 that states: *“Biomarkers provide an important indication of drinking status when used appropriately, but they must always be used with clear understanding of their strengths and weaknesses.”*

Another article recently published by the National Association of Drug Court Professionals states: *“Ethyl Glucuronide remains an effective alcohol abstinence monitoring tool that permits rapid therapeutic intervention.”*

The 24/7 SleepTime Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Monitoring System, a product of StreeTime Technologies, uses alcohol levels along with Ethyl Glucuronide to confirm beverage alcohol consumption.

In his statement, Crucilla says “EtG tests called for by SleepTime provides one of the most effective tools for validating abstinence.”

He further explains how EtG testing is used within the SleepTime monitoring system and how SleepTime will continue to be a behavioral motivator for drug courts, probation departments and treatment facilities.
